P. E. ISLANDERS ABROAD CONCERT AT MURRAY HARBOR NORTH.

In the beautiful town of Westboro, Mass., almost surrounded by hills, a company of Islanders met on Monday evening, January 23rd, 1905 at the home of Mrs. J. Y. Burhoe to celebrate her 82nd birthday. Mrs. Burhoe is a native of P. E. Island being born at Alexandra, Lot 49, Jan. 23rd, 1823.

She is the daughter of Theophilus and Mrs. Wood, long since passed on to their heavenly reward; was the wife of the late John Y. Burhoe living on the Island until 22 years ago, when they came to Westboro, Mass., where she still resides. On this the anniversary of her 82nd birthday she met six of her nine living children, fourteen of her grand children, (she has forty-five living) and two great grand children out of eleven, and her only living brother Theo. M. Wood. There were twenty-five P. E. Islanders present and quite a number of Westboro friends.
