**Canadian Writer Analyzes Ghosts of Henry James**  
 (Canadian Press)  
 Years before the current revival of interest in the life and work of Henry James, a young Canadian newspaper man was digging into them alone—partly from personal enthusiasm, partly from the scholarly bent he combined with a reporter's curiosity.  
 From time to time a monograph would appear, or an article in one of the university quarterlies, until Leon Edel's latest, a young man chosen to mean that here was a fresh approach to some aspect of James. It was a turning of the mirror so that James' acts and habits of thought were related to the stories he wrote half a century ago, and a picture composed in the light of a new reflection.  
 Edel's latest, labor of love in his chosen field is embodied in a 765-page collection, The Ghostly Tales of Henry James, (Rutgers University Press; Smithers, and Bonville, Toronto), in which he has gathered 18 stories and fitted them with notes and an introduction.  
 These are not ordinary "ghost" stories. For the most part the spirits haunt people rather than places. They are ghosts that come from fears and obsessions. Edel points out that most of James' ghostly tales were written during a middle period—after he had made a fine critical success as a novelist, but before he had attained popular recognition. At the end of this period, "Henry James could step outside the haunted tenement of himself, and wanted once again to write the 'haunter human order. . . The Phantoms were gone; the ghosts had been laid. He was ready to write his last and greatest novel."  
 Edel, who got his early education in Yorkton, Sask., has been a newspaper man for more than 20 years. While attending McGill he worked for the Montreal Herald and The Star, was Paris correspondent for the Star 1928-32, and later music and drama editor and news editor of The Herald. After a term with Hvas in New York and Paris, he joined The Canadian Press in 1938 and worked in Montreal, Toronto and New York. He joined the New York evening newspaper PM in 1942.  
 With humor and refreshing candor, Nancy Jones of Winnipeg has written "For Goodness Sake" (Ryerson), an autobiography of life in a Canadian manse.  
 Perhaps one should say in Canadian manse, for Mrs. Jones, wife of Rev. E. J. Jones, United Church minister, has lived in many places both in eastern and mid-western Canada.  
 Mrs. Jones has a lively eye for the humorous and incongruous. The ready-furnished parsonages, camping holidays, family pets, new congregations, the battle of the budget, she writes of them all with sympathetic wit.  
 But it is the woman herself with her sincere and positive approach to the variety and problems of her migratory life that stands out above all her experiences. She has developed a gen-
