WINTER TRANSPORTATION.

Every Province of Canada except Prince Edward Island enjoys transportation by settled routes through the year. They can send their products freely from Province to Province or to the markets of the world at all times. With the Island the changed and changing conditions of the cold season cause endless difficulties. Fortunately so far, the western port of Summerside has kept open. But it may close to the Navigation Company's boats any day.

They will begin our long series of winter trials. The freight coming to the Island via Point de Chene, must be re-shipped to Pictou, a circuit of 130 miles. The freight sent to Summerside must be re-shipped to Charlottetown. Then without notice the winter boats will abandon Charlottetown and the freight sent to this port from all parts of the Island must be re-shipped to Georgesville. Later with almost inevitable certainty Pictou will become blocked and all shipping business suspended for an indefinite time.

The Tunnel would cure all this. It would give certainty where all is now uncertainty. It would give one route instead of the many shifts from port to port. It would avoid all these worrying delays, costly transshipments and re-shipments. It would make us independent of closed ports, or winter storms. It would give passage for mails and passengers both outwards and inwards both morning and evening.

In no other way can we have the terms of union fulfilled. In no other way can we have the pledges of Sir John Macdonald and Sir Wilfrid Laurier honestly carried out. We are glad to find that Mr. McLean, M. P. for Queens has taken the first opportunity afforded by the debate on the Address to bring this vital question again before Parliament. We trust that our Island representatives will do so again and again until a definite pledge is obtained to proceed with the construction of the Tunnel.

The party papers are still trying to explain why the Conservatives abandoned St. John and why the Liberals abandoned London and lost Colchester.

Technically Hon. Dr. Pugsley is right in declining Mr. Borden's proposal for a royal commission to inquire into the conduct of both parties in the election of 1904. But we fail to see that his challenge to Mr. Borden to bring an action for libel could be or ought to be accepted. The best thing to do is to safeguard the next general election.

St. John has been relieved from her water famine by the repair of the broken mains. But the trouble will almost inevitably recur. The water is brought from a distance of ten miles or so and the old pipes will not stand the additional pressure brought about by recent connections with a lake upon a higher level. St. John

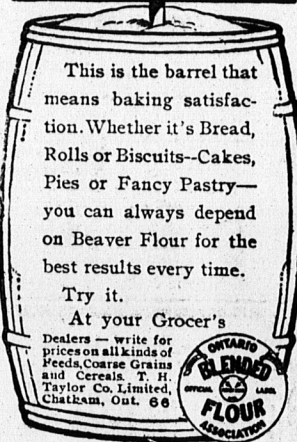
has expended in all some two million dollars on her water supply system—speaking from memory.

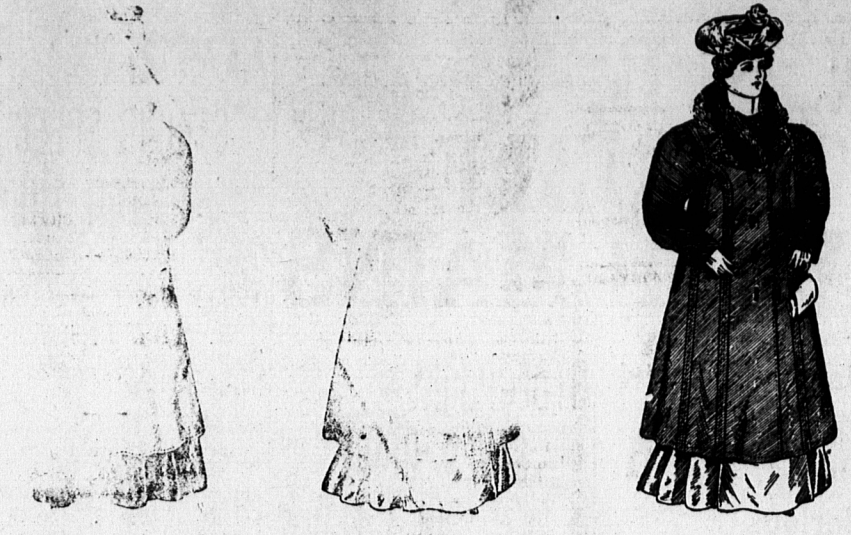
