In addition to holding his B.A. degree from Mount Allison University, he was born at Blackhead, Newfoundland, the son of a Methodist clergyman, who was pastor of the Methodist church Moncton from 1867 to 1870. It was at Mount Allison University that he received his education, being granted the degree of Bachelor of Arts in 1863 with his classmate, Hon. Josiah Wood. It was in Sackville that he



Doctor of Divinity from the local university. The new Dean has held many positions of importance in the Methodist conference of New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island and is known as one of the most scholarly clergymen of the denomination in Canada. He will probably go to Sackville in July next.

## AN ENGLISH AERONAUT'S ACCOUNT

### Eclipses All Records for Aeroplane Flying

PARIS, March 24.—Henry Farman, eclipsed all previous records for aeroplane flying, by making a circular flight with his machine of over two kilometres. A kilometre is about three-quarters of a mile. The machine mounted to a considerable height, and Mr. Farman turned and swerved it with the greatest daring to show that the machine was under perfect control. The spectators gave the aeronaut an ovation when he landed.

Mr. Farman, on January 11th last, at Issy, twice completed a one kilometre circular with his aeroplane in an endeavor to win the Deutsch-Archdeacon prize of \$30,000, which was offered for a heavier-than-air machine making a circular kilometre. The record was not allowed, however, owing to the fact that the committee having supervision over the award was not present.

Two days later, however, Mr. Farman described a circular kilometre with his machine in one minute and twenty-eight seconds in the presence of an official of the committee of the Aero Club, and was awarded the prize. Aeronauts at that time considered the achievement of the heavier-than-air machine of Mr. Farman the greatest since Santos Dumont circumnavigated the Eiffel Tower.
