Word has been received by Mrs. Margaret Nicholson, of Montague, that her husband, Sgt. N. Douglas Nicholson, of the Canadian Forestry Corps has been awarded the Canadian Efficiency Medal in respect of his service in the Reserve Force.

Sgt. Nicholson enlisted in the P. E. I. Highlanders early in September 1939, and was posted to Halifax, where he served until the summer of 1941, when he was sent to Camp Valcartier, Quebec. He was promoted to Staff in January 1941 and later to Sgt. and then to Corporal. He was in Newfoundland, after which he returned to the rank of Sgt. transferred to the Canadian Forestry Corps and was overseas in March 1942. Sgt. Nicholson went to France shortly after D-Day and is now in Germany. He is the son of Mr. N. J. Nicholson of Montague, P. E. I. Another brother Harold has been a prisoner of war in Japan, since the fall of Hong Kong.
