NEW YORK, July 8.—Vilhjalmar Stefansson, explorer, the man who tamed the Arctic, and had spent years north of the Polar circle, has been routed by the hot wave here. He left Thursday night for Glacier, British Columbia, where he will spend the rest of the summer.

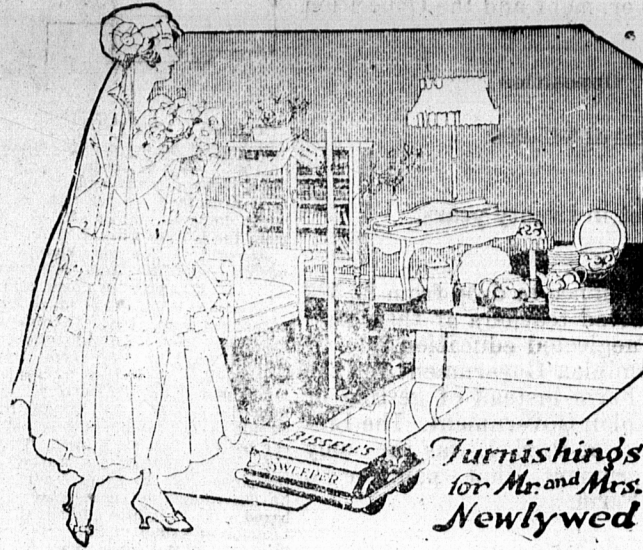
Mr. Stefansson has evolved a theory that sub-tropical climates is subversive of intellectual activity. "Hot weather is vitiating physically and mentally," he explained. "Go up north, and after a while you are full of energy, and you are eager to get back to work."

"I believe that in the future—the near future—scientists will turn their serious attention to the study of climate on intellectual development and progress. In fact, it is already attracting their notice. The trend of civilization is northward, or away from the tropics, and I believe that the northern part of the United States and Canada will develop the best products of our civilization. Fair Price Court To Have Wide Powers

OTTAWA, July 7.—Wide powers to deal with combines and to prevent hoarding as a means of unduly enhancing prices will be conferred upon the Board of Commerce to be established under the legislation introduced by Hon. Arthur Meighen, the Acting Minister of Justice, in the Commons. Two bills have been put before Parliament by Mr. Meighen. One of them provides for the creation of the Board of Commerce, consisting of three members, and the other entitled the "Combines and Fair Prices Act" embodies the regulations to be enforced by the new tribunal. The Board of Commerce will consist of a chairman, who must be a judge or a barrister of ten years' standing, and assistant chairman and a third commissioner. These commissioners are to hold office for a period of ten years, and are to be given power and direction to restrain and prohibit the formation and operation of combines. The board is to have all the powers of a court, and will be able to proceed against a combine or alleged combine either on its own motion or on the complaint of any citizen. It is to be given large inquisitorial powers, including the right to demand from any firms or individuals returns of stocks of goods on hand. It may deal with any person or firm which accumulates or withholds from sale necessities of life beyond an amount reasonably required for the use or consumption of his household or for the ordinary purposes of his business. An appeal from a decision of the Board on a question of fact will lie to the Governor in Council, and on a question of law to the Supreme Court of Canada. One of the most important features of the legislation is that the Board of Commerce will be able to proceed itself against persons accused of hoarding or of combines to enhance prices, or it may refer the case to the Attorney-General of a province with a recommendation that criminal proceedings be instituted. Under the Order-in-Council respecting the cost of living, enacted a few years ago, proceedings could only be taken by the Cost of Living Commissioner through the Attorney-General of the provinces.
