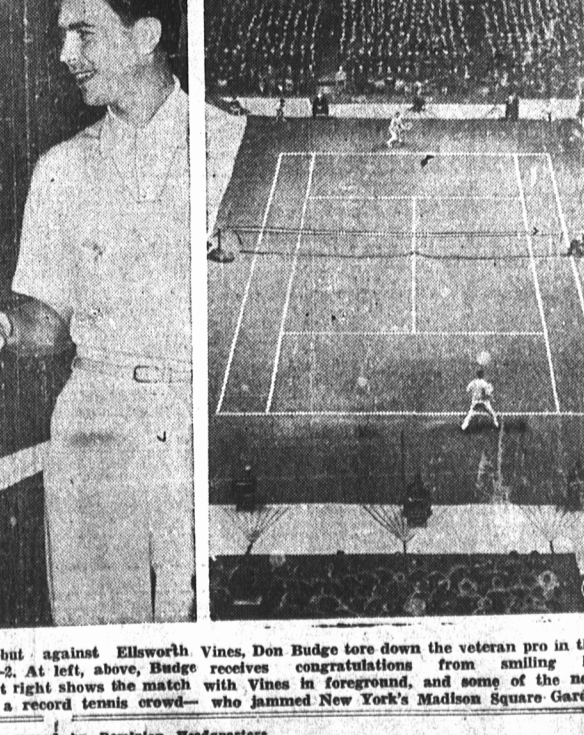
"Buck" Newsom Looms Holdout
