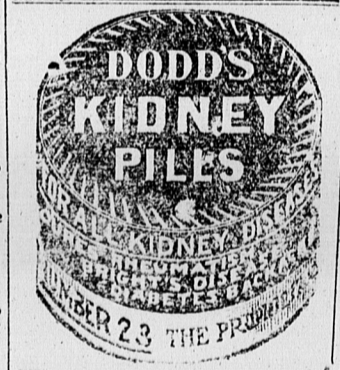
Of iron and steel and manufactures thereof Canada imported \$11,212,644 from Britain and \$48,040,159 from the States. Of leather and manufactures thereof the values were \$949,011 from Britain and \$3,176,755 from the States.

THE REFORM LEAGUE.

Prior to the elections of 1908 the Moral and Social Reform League was called into existence for the laudable purpose of securing the observance of the laws in regard to purity of elections. An especial object was to discountenance and suppress the use of money and intoxicants for corrupt purposes, an evil which had previously attained serious proportions.

The League was organized both locally and provincially and entered upon its work with zeal and earnestness. Prominent and able speakers were secured to address public meetings and conduct a campaign of education in election purity along with the political campaign.

We believe that much good resulted from the efforts put forth by the Reform League, as was apparent during the campaign and on polling day. This was further certified by His Lordship Chief Justice Sullivan in delivering judgment in a federal election trial at a later date when he remarked that the campaign appeared to have been exceptionally free from corrupt and unlawful acts.

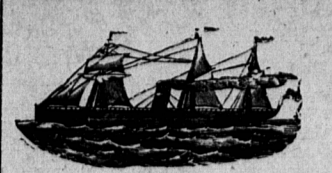

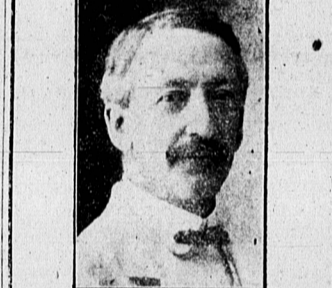

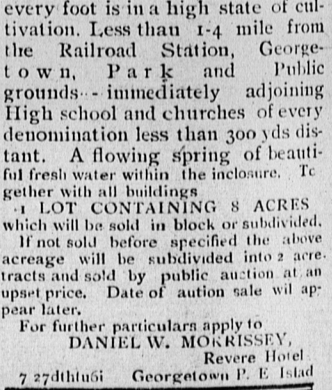
