Canadian Ship Beats American Across Pacific

VANCOUVER, Dec. 18.—The liner Empress of Asia, outbound, on her last voyage, made an effective speed demonstration. The liner President Jackson, of the Admiral Oriental Service, left Victoria at 9.10 o'clock on the evening of November 29. The Asia left Victoria at 6.45 p.m. on November 30, more than twenty-one hours behind the American express liner. The Canadian ship arrived at Yokohama at 8 a.m. December 11, seven hours and thirty minutes ahead of the Jackson which reached there at 3.30 p.m. that day.

Christmas aboard a Canadian Pacific liner will be the theme of many a letter written by passengers who sailed yesterday for the Orient on board the S.S. Empress of Canada for Christmas Day should find the palatial ship one day out of Yokohama.

Everything has been arranged to provide all the comforts of the "Fulelle" season on that occasion. Two large Christmas trees were taken on board. The ship's purser will impersonate Santa Claus and every youngster on the ship will receive gifts on Christmas morning.

FARMERS RAISIN BREAD

4 cups cornmeal, 2 cups rye flour, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 cup molasses, 1 tablespoon salt, 1 cup water, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 2 cups sour milk or buttermilk, 2 tablespoons melted shortening, 1 cup seeded Sun-maid raisins.

Mix and sift all the dry ingredients together; stir in the raisins and the rest of the ingredients in order given. Mix thoroughly and pour into two well greased loaf pans. Bake about forty-five minutes in an oven heated to 400 degrees Fahrenheit.

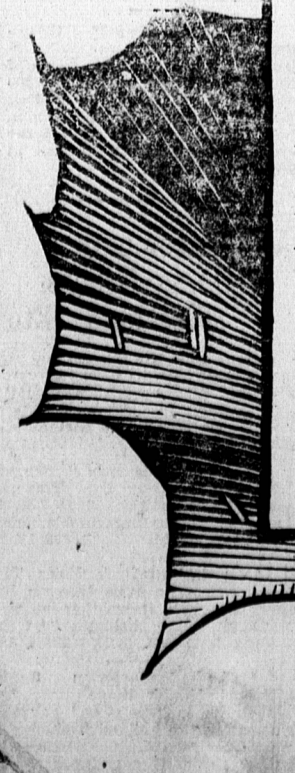
