THE TWO ORPHANS

The old quarter of Paris where the Pont Neuf crosses the Seine—the river that winds serpent-like through "The City Beautiful"—rise the two square black towers of Notre Dame—the church whose every stone is steeped in legend and history. Torn asunder almost at the moment of entering Paris through the subsequent suffering of each—runs a thread of pure and sacrificing love like a gleam of a star in a cloudy tempestuous night, till the clouds of misfortune roll away and a bright and happy dawn is theirs. "Henriette's" misfortunes and honest ingenious nature win for her the devotion of a chivalrous and high-minded nobleman, while the poor little blind foundling "Louise" is worshipped like a saint by the cripple "Pierre" and through his efforts is restored to the arms of her mother the Countess de Linieres.
