### CLOSING STOCK LETTER,

Dec. 10, 1910.

NEW YORK—Randolph says—Although it was hard to trace the source of buying orders in the market during the first hour, there seemed to be a continually increasing demand with a decreased supply of stocks and prices in that period moved up with a fair amount of vigor, gains of one point or more being made in the leading issues after the fractional declines in the first few minutes. The most important factor influencing trade on the bull side was the decision in the Anthracite coal case, published yesterday, which over night met with more favorable construction and today was taken as a bull factor of high importance. Reading became again one of the leaders. Lehigh was also active and strong and all the stocks of the companies that are classed as among the coal carriers and producers shared in the substantial improvement. Union and St. Paul were both active and strong with the room attributing the strength in these issues to a change in the position of the Rockefeller interests. Steel Common showed a better tone, making a fractional upturn. Virginia Chemical has been listed on the Paris course. Just after the close it was announced that the U. S. Steel Corporation in its monthly report of unfilled tonnage showed unfilled orders on its books up to Nov. 30 of 2,760,000 tons, a decrease of only 111,536 tons. The tone at the close was strong, a little below the highest of the day. The Bank Statement was better than expected. Canadian Pacific first week decrease gross \$1,973,000. Increase \$68,000. Total sales 263,155.

### CLOSING COTTON LETTER

(From F. B. McCurdy & Co's Private Wire.)

NEW YORK, Dec. 10—The market has been called upon to absorb a good deal of selling on cotton today and showed some irregularity in the consequence, but no weak features have developed, and the situation appears to be shaping quite in accordance with bullish expectations. The Government estimate of the yield points to a commercial crop of about 11,800,000 bales, and if the Government's estimate is as near the total as we were last season we see no reason why this figure should be exceeded for certainly no cotton was carried over from last year in the interior. And using this figure as a basis the available supply for the season would not seem to be much in excess of last year. With the American crop probably 1,200,000 bales larger the prospects for an East India crop of 750,000 bales less and while the outlook is for a larger Russian and Egyptian crop we must remember that we carried forward on to this season something like 750,000 bales less in the visible supply than last season and that stocks in the hands of spinners also showed a big reduction compared with the previous year. We cannot figure anything but a bullish situation and unless there is some very disturbing general trade conditions at present unforseen, we must be prepared to see cotton sell at very much higher prices.

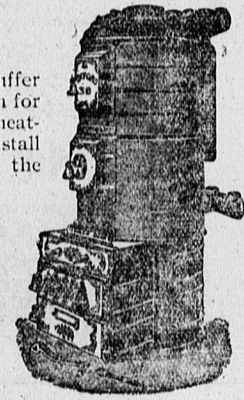
