FLIES ON THE WINDOW PANES (4)

Resuming the list from last week, we have: (10) Tephrochlamys caesecans Meigen. A small fly, body about one-eighth of an inch long. Adults frequent shady places. Curran recommends burying a tin can with its open end flush with the ground, and examining it early in the morning, to capture these flies. The larvae are seen on the walls of the tin.

OLD ENGLAND (5)

The Neolithic folk, like their predecessors, had to face invaders from the south. The newcomers, who seem to have come from Spain, have been called "Beaker People" by antiquaries, because they introduced bell-shaped pots or beakers, which were decorated by the impression of finely footed stamps. They are supposed to have come to Britain about 1,500 B.C.
