Stock Leaders Stage Recovery In New York New York Stock Exchange Slight Gains Registered On Montreal Mart

(By Frederick Gardner, Associated Press Financial Writer) NEW YORK, March 24—(AP)—Stock market leaders look on a recovery in today's market. While more active issues succeeded in regaining fractions to a point or so of their recent set-back, in the list as a whole advances only slightly outnumbered declines at the close. The list edged forward at the start, then drifted into new low territory for the past two years or longer. There was a subsequent quiet forward tilt confined principally to Steels, Motors, Coppers, Rails and specialties. Transfers totaled 890,160 compared with 1,468,400 the day before. Owing to one or two soft spots in the Associated Press composite, the average of 60 stocks was unchanged at 38.8. Fractional improvements were sprinkled about a sluggish Canadian list. Lake Shore advanced 11-8 points to 49-7-8. Minor improvements were noted by St. Nicholas, Seagrams, Dome, International Nickel, Waples and Marconi. McIntyre was easy.

RHEUMATISM IN CHILDREN

According to recent statistics rheumatism is the second most crippling disease of childhood. rickets taking first place. For some years past special clinics have been run in large cities for the benefit of children suffering from this disease. One of the chief difficulties met in the effort to stamp out rheumatism in childhood lies in the fact that the majority of parents are still unwilling to recognize fatigue, listlessness and "growing pains" in their children as likely symptoms of this complaint. In consequence they regard the doctor's insistence on complete rest as a drastic measure and an unnecessary precaution and do not follow the advice until the trouble has taken a definite hold of the child's system. The great danger attending the form of rheumatism found among children and young people is that the valves of the heart become "roughened" as the trouble develops and when the organ is given complete rest, and this leads all too quickly to permanent cardiac complications which can never be permanently cured. The mother of a child who appears listless and tired when he or she should be full of health and spirits, who prefers to sit quietly rather than join in games with other children, who complains of aching limbs and tends to lose color and appear peaked, should consult a doctor without delay. These are danger signs which must not be ignored. Most large welfare centers and children's hospitals have special Rheumatism Clinics where the child can be examined by a specialist and where up-to-date advice will probably be carried out according to instructions.
