**REGULATING THE USE  
OF THE NIAGARA**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 3.—A favorable report on a bill for general regulation of the use of the water of Niagara river for power purposes, was agreed upon late to-day by the house foreign affairs committee. The measure would provide that the secretary of war issue permits for the diversion of water of the American side, upon condition that the company receiving it shall comply with any and all regulations as to rates and service of the state in which power is generated or transmitted. No change would be made in the existing law limiting the amount of water to be diverted on the American side to 15,000 cubic feet a second.

The secretary would be authorized to issue permits for the diversion of water below as well as above the falls, and for the transmission of power from the Canadian side and would be directed in issuing permits for plants above the falls to have due regard for those investments which already have been made.

Under the proposed law all persons or companies now holding permits for the diversion of water would be required to reconstruct their plants within five years after notice from the secretary of war. The secretary also would be authorized to revoke any permits after five years' notice, if he should determine that the diversions of water interfered with the navigable capacity of the river, its efficiency as a boundary stream, its efficiency as a means of national defense, or the scenic grandeur of Niagara Falls, or that the water diverted was not being used to its proper standard of efficiency.
