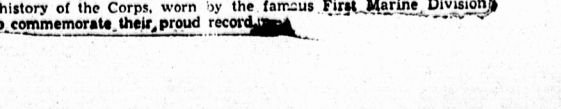

Two Years After Guadalcanal - Our First 'D-Day'



When the United States Marines hit the beaches of Guadalcanal, Tulagi and Gavutu Islands in the Solomons on Aug. 7, 1942, it marked America's first 'D-Day'. The first American invasion against aggressive nations on more and more Japanese possessions with increasing rapidity, culminating in the double blow at Guam and Tinian. As the Guadalcanal campaign dragged out for six months, the jungles, swamps and mosquitoes of the Solomon Islands bred in the Marines and Army infantrymen a new concept of war and their progress on Saipan and on Guam testifies that they learned their lessons well. Inserted on the photo of Marines moving up on Guadalcanal is a 'D-Day' patch, first of its kind in the history of the Corps, worn by the famous First Marine Division to commemorate their proud record.
