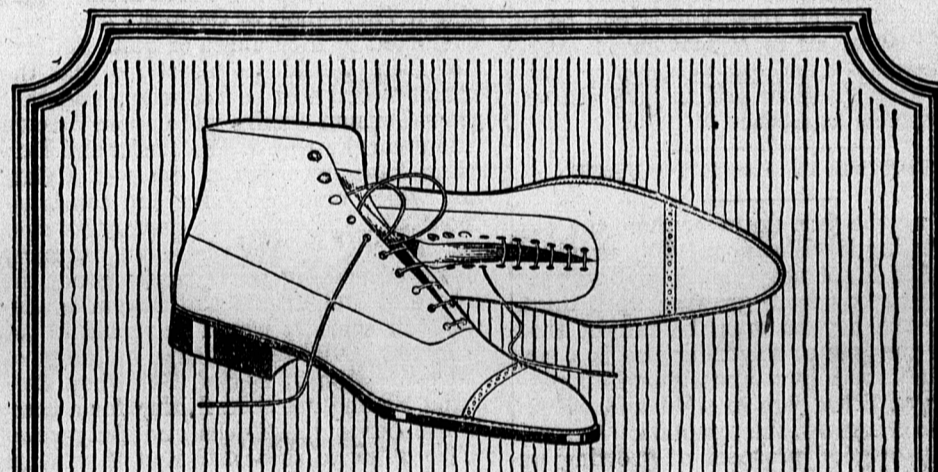

AUTO ARRANGEMENTS FOR EXHIBITION.—The Tuesday and Friday auto restrictions on all roads in the province, have been removed during exhibition week and cars crossing Hillsborough Bridge shall have the same privileges as on other days of the week. Between Weymouth Street and the eastern boundary of the Exhibition grounds cars eastwardly must go by Fitzroy Street or Kent Street and the Kensington Road; returning by Park Street and Grafton Street past Rifle Range and Pork Factory.
