LETTER FROM INSPECTOR JENKINS.

Sir,—I do not think it necessary, nor do I intend to enter into any newspaper controversy over this drugist's business. I owe it, however, to the citizens and to myself to say a few words at this time.

When I went to the City a few weeks ago to aid in enforcing the Prohibition Law I found that much of the liquor being sold was supplied by some of the drugists of the City. I do not think I would have gone beyond my duty as Inspector had I at once entered cases against them. This I did not do, but called on them personally, asking them to observe the law, as no favors would be shown; and, if I found any one guilty of violating the statute, they would be summarily dealt with. Several of them confessed that they had been guilty in the past, but said if given a chance, I would never have another occasion for complaint. I further warned them that they would be watched and would need to exercise care. A short time ago complaint was made that some of the drugists were again selling. So wishing to ascertain the correctness of this charge I asked Mr. Leatham to call and find out to what extent the law was violated. He reported three selling openly and that all the others positively refused to sell.

No deception was used in any way to my knowledge, and Mr. Leatham says there was no difficulty in getting all one wanted. No questions were asked, the brandy was passed out and the money taken. Sales were not made to him alone, but to others in his presence.

I would ask the citizens to reserve their judgment until such time as one of the drugists of the City will charge me over his own signature with dealing unfairly, or in an underhand way, with them. All this talk about a sick wife, &c., is only nonsense and idle gossip.

I want to say just here if the citizens of Charlottetown expect me to force the ordinary saloon keeper to the wall and let some of the drugists have a free hand to sell they have the wrong man as Inspector. Whilst I hold the position I do I will enforce the Law as far as I can, with favors to none, whether rich or poor, high or low.

Since going to the City I have been treated in the most kindly way by the Magistrate, police officers, and citizens and even the saloon keepers have shown me all due respect and I entertain for them the most kindly feelings, but I am opposed to their business, and expect to remain so for all time.
