How Can I!!!

Q. How can I save time when cleaning the table silver?

A. Make a solution of one quart of boiling water, one teaspoonful of baking soda, and one teaspoonful of salt. Pour into an aluminum vessel and place the silver in it. Allow it to remain for a few minutes, then rinse with clear hot water. Clean the vessel at once.

Q. How can I whiten clothes?

A. Put a few slices of lemon, with the rind on, in the boiler and boil with the white clothes. This removes stains and makes the clothes white without injury.

Q. How can I remove ink stains from washable fabrics?

A. Cover the spot with a paste made of starch and butter. Allow this paste to dry and then wash the goods in warm water.

SCOTCH PANCAKES

2 cups cooked oatmeal
2 cups ground cooked meat
2 eggs
2 tablespoons lard or drippings
Combine oatmeal, meat, eggs and seasonings. Mix thoroughly. Fry cakes, using 1 tablespoonful of mixture in each, in small amount of hot fat. Serve hot.

PEANUT COOKIES

4 tablespoons shortening (this sample is made with chicken fat rendered from a fat stewing chicken)
1/2 cup fine granulated sugar
1/2 cup brown sugar (lightly packed)
1/2 teaspoon vanilla; few drops almond flavoring
2 cups once-sifted pastry flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 cups salted peanuts (coarsely ground) choppe

By an Island Farmer's Wife

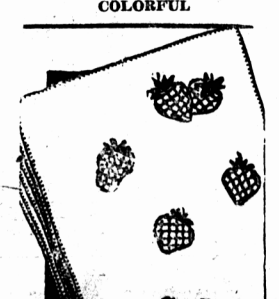

The disagreeable odour of commercial carbon bisulphide, or disulfide, is due to the presence of other sulphur compounds as impurities. Pure carbon bisulphide is practically odourless.

Ozone a modification of oxygen whose molecule contains three atoms of oxygen. Instead of the usual two, it is a strong oxidizing agent and is used as a disinfectant for drinking water and swimming pools.

More than half the carbon bisulphide produced in the United States is used in the manufacture of rayon, cellophane and other viscose products; the next greatest use is in making carbon tetrachloride.
