**R. F. MacCharles Goes To Montreal C.N.R.**

MONTREAL, N. B., June 3 —The  
 appointment of R. F. MacCharles  
 as assistant regional auditor, Can-  
 adian National Railways, with  
 headquarters at Moncton is an-  
 nounced by C. M. Brown, regional  
 auditor, succeeding Russell F. Mac-  
 Charles, who has been promoted  
 to the position of chief disburse-  
 ments accountant in the audit  
 department at system headquar-  
 ters in Montreal. Russell F. Mac-  
 Charles was born at Farmington,  
 N.S., and joined the railway as a  
 clerk in the accounting department  
 at Moncton in July 1915. He was  
 made travelling accountant in  
 March 1926, chief bookkeeper Ap-  
 ril 1934, accountant October 1935,  
 and was appointed assistant re-  
 gional auditor January 1, 1946. He  
 is a veteran of the first world  
 war, enlisting in April 1916 and  
 demobilized in July 1919, follow-  
 ing which he resumed his service  
 with the railway.
