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ALL THESE THINGS ARE AGAINST ME.
 Sermon by Rev. Dr. Lorenz, Presbyterian, New York.
AN HARD LUCK LESSON.
 No Conflict no Victory—God a Helmsman Though We Sail Troubled Waters.
 "All these things are against me," Genesis, xliii, 33.
 There is something pathetic about the patriarchal figure of Jacob, with his dishevelled hair and vulture grief. The imprisonment of Simeon and his haughty Egyptian ruler's demand for his young and best-beloved Benjamin, the last legacy of his favorite Rachel, opened afresh an old wound, his sorrow over the long-lost Joseph. Small wonder that his anguish became articulate in the querulous complaint, "All these things are against me."
 These words, first of all, evidence a lack of knowledge. Joseph, needlessly lamented, was a right royal ruler; Simeon was in the line of promotion from a prison to a palace, and Benjamin, together with all of Jacob's family, was to dwell in plenty and prosperity in fair Goshen by the Nile.
 Ignorance in itself is not a serious charge. The confession of ignorance may be a manly and praiseworthy act. The wisest of men know very well that they are not guessing at truth. While they are quite right that hero worship is a vital ingredient in human nature, the wiser a man becomes the more difficult he finds it to keep his supposed heroes from tottering on their pedestals. Instead of realizing the ideal man he is compelled to idealize the real man.
 The serious charge against other people, besides Jacob is not ignorance, but that, being ignorant, they speak with an air of finality, as though they were the highest court of appeal. It may be largely a misfortune if a person's eyes are jaundiced, but it becomes a fault if he asserts that the defect is in the light of heaven.
 A pity it is that men should pass judgment upon the structure when the first rude outer walls are beginning to stretch their bare arms toward heaven, instead of waiting until the full, beautiful plan is disclosed without and within. Far better to wait and see whether there may not be a smiling face behind the frowning Providence.
 These words, "All these things are against me," also evidence a lack of gratitude.
 Surely all things had not been against Jacob in the past. Was Bethel against him when, as a youth, his vaulting ambition having reeled itself, he lay on his desert bed and communed with angels and covenanted with God? Was Peniel against him when, standing in mortal danger, the angel of the Lord came to his kneeling side, turning the ancient feud of Esau into fraternal favor?
 Ingratitude does not consist only in despising blessings, but in not desiring privations; not only in minimizing miseries, but in magnifying miseries. Many people are minded the rather to read the Book of Lamentations, one of whose chapters begins, "I am the man that hath seen affliction by the rod of His wrath," rather than the 103rd Psalm, which opens "Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me bless His holy name."
 May we be kept from that song that is always in the minor key, from that grim, melancholy that constantly has an east wind blowing. May we guard against that morbid and lean philosophy, always told in mournful numbers, that life is but an empty dream; may we find the tree of sweet and antidoting properties beside every bitter pool of Marah waters!
 These words, "All these things are against me," evidence as well a lack of trust.
 Suppose Jacob's grieved surmises had been true—for better people than Jacob have had worse misfortunes—would that have given any less reason for trusting? No. Faith in God does not imply that we may have a cheerful confidence that everything will always be brought about—our way. Genuine trust is to believe in the darkest night that the sun shall rise, and to keep on believing, although the morning seems long in coming.
 Even in this world we may be sure there is an answer to all our hard riddles, even though we do not know what is the answer. Although we see through a glass darkly—the more darkly because human eyes are often blinded by tears—yet we shall see face to face.
 God is still at the helm, though it be through troubled waters. That man's name is faithlessness who does not include God in his reckoning, and who does not believe that God includes him in His reckoning.
 The words "All these things are against me" further evidence a lack of courage.
 It is a pity business to sit down among our trials, like a whimpering child among its broken toys. Why, that is the story of life—it is one steady, workaday struggle. No man is half a man who does not constantly seek to reverse reverses.
 Jacob did not find life a flowery bed of ease, and neither have we. Yet no one but a weakling will be content to droop and repine and give up the ship. "All these things are against us?" Of course they are, and we are to be against these things.
 What does the world need most and prize most? Why, grit, power, success—a spirit which never says die. Men thus animated win the day because
