PRECAUTION NECESSARY.— At a meeting of the Board of Health for Lot 52-59-61 held at Montague on Saturday 21st at which Mr. W. L. Poole, chairman presided, and a majority of the members were present and an adjourned meeting held on Sunday 22nd it was ordered that owing to the presence of influenza in southern Kings County and the danger of same spreading to parts within this jurisdiction that all schools be closed, and that all church meetings, public gatherings, lodges and all places of amusements be also closed until further notice and that attending physicians be instructed to flag all houses in which there may happen to be any cases of influenza and to see that the quarantine is rigidly enforced until such time as same is removed in due course.

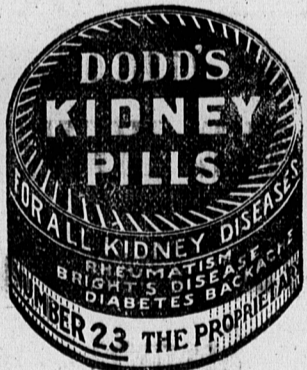

***PURCHASES FACTORY.**— Dr. McIntyre, Montague, has purchased the lobster factory of William Pope at Campbell's Cove. The Doctor already owns factories at East Point.

***INFLUENZA SPREADING.**— An epidemic of influenza of a very virulent type is rapidly spreading throughout the southern parts of King's County. A large number of cases are reported together with quite a number of deaths. Some of the local boards of health are endeavouring to enforce methods to prevent its spreading such as closing the schools, prohibiting church meetings and other public gatherings, and have given instructions to attending physicians to isolate all patients within their homes as far as possible, and to flag or placard all such homes to prevent either intentional or accidental intercourse with the public but notwithstanding these precautions new cases are continually developing. As this disease is epidemic and highly contagious, and as local Boards of Health are confined in their jurisdiction to comparatively small areas, and the different local Boards cannot work in concert to provide protection for the large area now infected, this would seem to be a case where the provincial Board of Health should act and take such means as may be necessary for promptly and effectually stopping the further spread, this disease said to count more deaths among its victims in about two years than the world war that has just entered caused in four years.

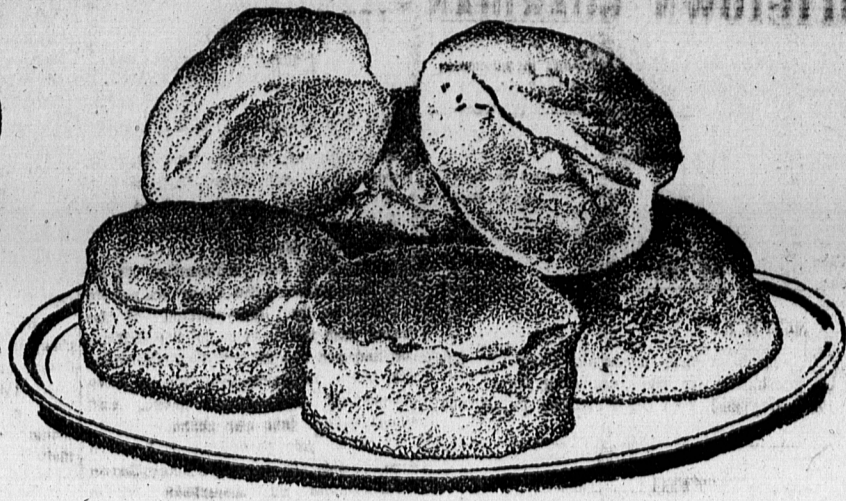

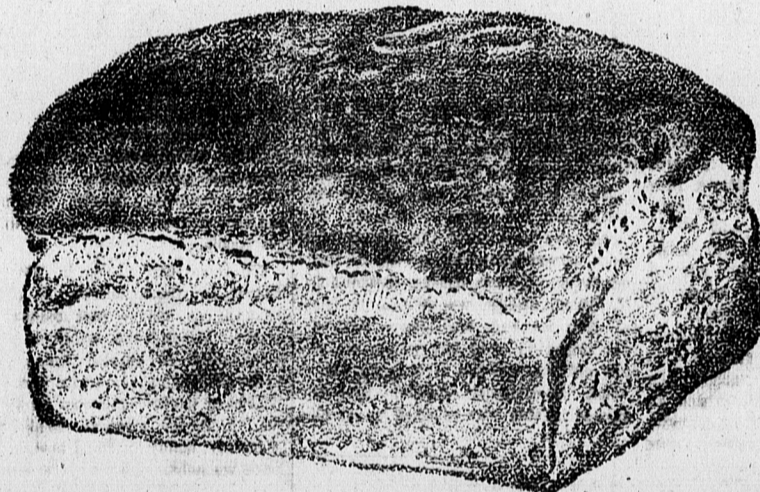
