MR BALFOUR'S RESIGNATION.

Mr Balfour, who led the last Unionist Ministry in the United Kingdom, in succession to the late Lord Salisbury from 1902 to 1905 and has since the latter date led the Opposition, has somewhat suddenly and unexpectedly resigned. The convenient excuse assigned by some of his friends though not by himself, is that his physicians have advised him that he ought not longer to bear the burden of night sessions and the heavy responsibilities of leadership. The real reason appears to be that the Opposition are almost hopelessly divided. The Opposition which Mr Balfour has led has two wings: The Conservatives and the Chamberlainites. From the Conservative wing a strong secession has been made under the leadership of Lord Halsbury, sometimes spoken of as the "last ditcher" because of their avowed resolve to fight to the last against the taking away of the veto power of the Lords. These were but a minority of the Opposition party, but were very determined in their revolt against Mr Balfour's leadership. Another line of cleavage was in regard to tariff reform, but that might have been got over for the time. Mr Balfour simply declined longer to lead a divided party, one section of which boldly challenged his right to lead. As has frequently occurred in political affairs, the division of the Opposition tends to strengthen the Government of the day. It will be a hard task for the Conservatives to find a successor to Mr Balfour of equal ability, unbanity, skill and astuteness and who has proved himself so well capable of leading a great party both in power and in Opposition. Perhaps even Mr Balfour himself did not recognise the change of sentiment that has come over the Kingdom, how privilege is disappearing and Government of the people by and for the people is taking its place. On the other hand there may be danger that, in the absence of united and effective opposition the Government of the day may proceed with its radical policy too fast and too far.

THE AFFAIRS OF CHINA

At this distance we know little of the great men who are at the head of affairs in China whether in leading the revolution or in sustaining the Manchu dynasty. A few years ago the name of Li Hung Chang was conspicuous among the modern statesmen of China because of his prominence at home and his extensive travels through Europe, the British Isles, Canada and the United States. Now our despatches make frequent mention of two other noted men, Yuan Shih Kai, and General Li Yuan Heng. The latter is the military leader of the revolutionists. Yuan Shih Kai is the newly appointed Premier of China.

AGAINST THE SAW-OFF.

The Ottawa Free Press, Liberal, says: "The saw-off agreed to is as much a violation of the law as any corrupt act committed in any constituency of Canada, and the politicians who agreed to it were as guilty of crime as the man who paid, or the man who accepted money for his vote on September 21 last."

The Christian Guardian, of Toronto, which speaks for one of the great religious bodies of Canada, says in regard to it: "And so there is peace! And yet there is something in it which stings the average man with a sense of keen disgrace. For these men were prepared to take a solemn oath that to their certain knowledge their successful opponents had violated the election laws. And yet by accepting these saw-offs, they tacitly admit or appear to do so, that the charges against their own side are just as true as those to which they are ready to take oath in the other case of their opponents. Surely it is time that Canadian politics shook itself free from this form of political cowardice."

One great trouble in the Christian world is the double standard of morals in regard to the individual and the state. The individual feels and observes a correct standard of right and justice towards other individuals. But the corporation has a much looser standard, on the ground that it has "no soul to save and no body to be kicked." Our political relations are corrupt and dishonest.
