PLAGUE AND THE "FLEA SEASON."

Some months ago attention was directed to the outbreak of plague among rats in Suffolk. Some alarm was expressed lest the epidemic should spread throughout the country, and a good deal of discussion took place with reference to the steps that ought to be taken not only to destroy the plague-infected animals but to exterminate the entire rat population—a much larger order, it is not a wholly impracticable one. Since the outbreak was detected the Local Government Board has conducted inquiries which have had a reassuring result. Throughout the country around Ipswich in the course of six weeks rats to the number of 6000 were captured and examined. It is believed the correspondent of "The Times" states, that very few of these were plague-infected. But he immediately proceeds to point out that the rats owe their infection to fleas, and that what without disparage may be called the flea season does not begin until autumn, and that it continues until summer, and that the time to watch the East Anglia most closely is not yet. He mentions that in the Glasgow outbreak of 1906 no rat was found infected with plague, "but as only 326 were examined the evidence proves very little." In the second outbreak in this city in 1901, 122 out of 1641 rats examined were found to be plague-infected. "The inference," he remarks, "is that plague existed among rats in Glasgow in 1900 but was not traced. A plague rat was found in Glasgow in 1907, when there were also two human cases."

The agency of rats as disseminators of plague is so marked in tropical countries that we cannot afford to ignore the mischievous potency of their presence in our own land. We described some time ago the apparently adequate measures which are taken by our harbor and sanitary authorities to prevent the entrance of infected rodents. But if there should prove to be a large area in the country itself whence the infection can spread, if the enemy is already within our gates, it will become a grave public question whether the handling of the rat nuisance should not be organized and supported from public funds. According to Dr. Cantlie, in the "Journal of Tropical Medicine," in countries where the rodent population is affected, the outlook is not hopeful. For as the correspondent adds, "we know far more about epidemics than men did in the days of Hippocrates, but science still leaves unanswered the riddle of the ultimate cause of their
