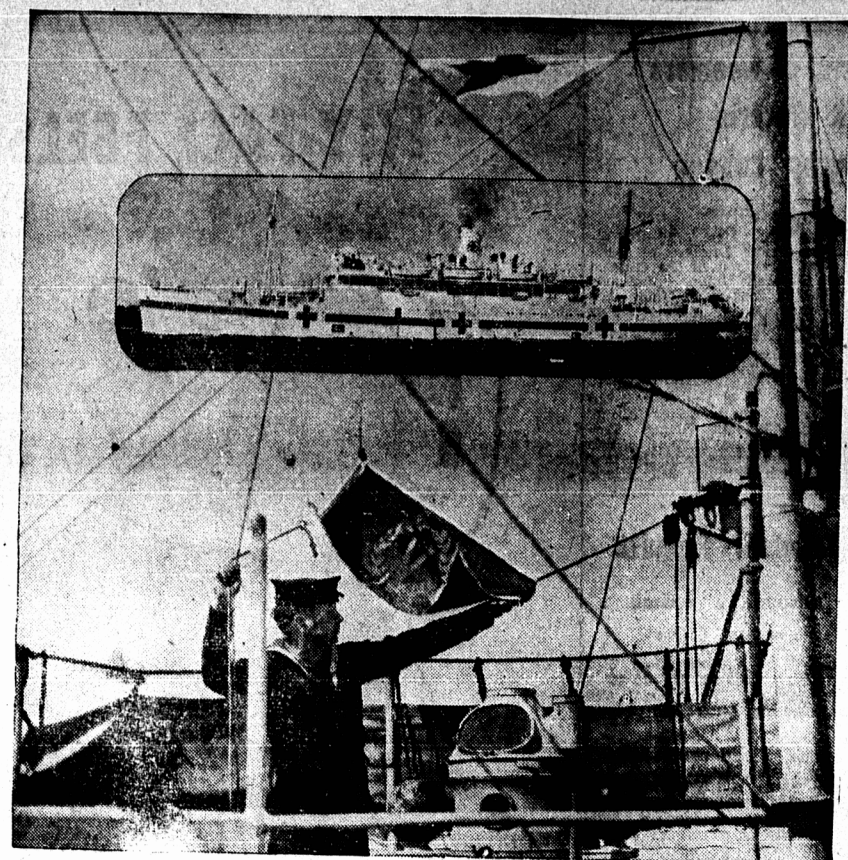

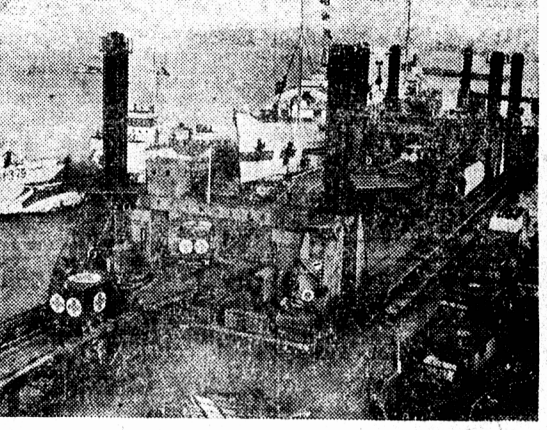

Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, May 27 — (AP) — Week-end profit cashing stalled grain markets for a time Saturday but the offerings were absorbed quickly and prices turned strongly high and selling at a new seasonal high while gaining nearly two cents a bushel.
WINNIPEG, May 27 — (CP) — Deferred months of rye futures prices gave a strong display on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange Saturday, July made sharp advances due to moderate local demand and light offerings. All months with the exception of December made new seasonal highs.
NEW YORK, May 27 — (AP) — Further demand for rails, a wide assortment of industrial and utilities, Saturday enabled the Stock Market to finish a rather erratic week with a display of strength that put the overall average at its highest level in nearly eight years. Transfers totalled 700,000 shares compared with 730,000 the previous day.

A miracle of Allied engineering built the portable harbours of France that liberated Europe. The same engineering genius now works at European reconstruction at the same time pursuing the war against Japan. The story of the construction of the great floating Harbour Goes to France, edited from a British Ministry of Information release into a one-reel film by the "Canada Carries On" production unit of the National Film Board. Pictured above is a section of the gigantic two-way traffic structure towed from England to France on D-Day. Making a port as big as Dover, seven miles in length, capable of deploying 12,000 tons of stores and 2,500 vehicles daily, the port were towed in 480-foot pieces across the channel surviving a three-day 70-mile-an-hour gale. Ambulances are shown above clearing casualties as army vehicles unload on the Normandy beach. "Goes to France" demonstrates the spirit and skill of Allied technicians and workmen who are healing the wounds of a battle to win the peace.

Paris Denies All Treason Accusations
 PARIS, May 26 — (AP) — Aged Marshal Petain tossed aside today the quiet, confident manner he had assumed since his voluntary return from Germany three weeks ago and in a preliminary court appearance began vigorously fighting the accusation that he collaborated with the Nazis.
 First he presented the French high court with an urgent letter addressed to Admiral William D. Leahy, former United States Ambassador to Vichy, asking that Ad-

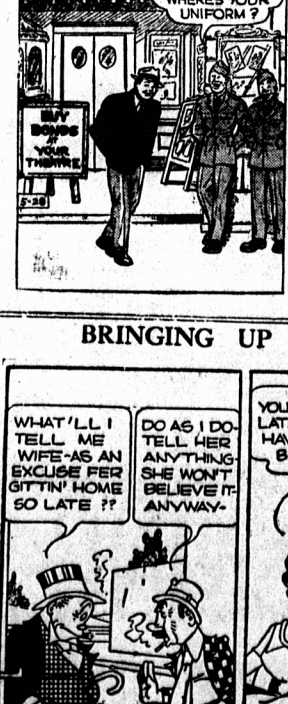
