THE Daily Columbian, New Westminster, B. C. says:—Mr. H. A. Munn of P. E. Island has been granted a patent for an invention which is described technically as "Portable and collapsible watertight compartments for boats, vessels and scows." This invention was the result of the inventor's experiences in the transportation of freight down the Yukon River in temporary craft, which, having arrived at their down river terminal and fulfilled their mission, are broken up and destroyed. The aim is to provide a pliable and removable lining to the interior or hold and also transverse bulkheads, so that in the event of a loaded craft accidentally striking a submerged boulder and breaking the planks at the bottom or sides, the cargo of the boat or scow is preserved uninjured. The invention is already in extensive use. It is an interesting fact that the first scow to go down the Yukon in June equipped with the "water tight" struck heavily in Thirty Mile, it being very low water at the time. Out of the \$5,000 cargo on board, only 35 worth was injured, while in ordinary cases a total loss would have resulted.
