Plan Formation Of Boys Band In Summerside Plans for the formation of a boys' band in Summerside were drawn up this week when members of the old band met Tuesday evening to consider the possibilities of the plan. To the local welfare officer, Pat Ryan, credit for getting the movement under way and a general meeting of the old members of the band who have volunteered as instructors, and the boys, will be held Thursday night to go into the details more fully. About twenty-five boys, ranging between the ages of 13 to 15 years, will be selected to form the band and at the meetings which have so far been held the enthusiasm has been running high among the young lads who all hope to have an instrument assigned to them. The formation of this band will fill a long felt want for it has been a source of regret that the Summerside girls band, of which the town was so justly proud, gradually disbanded, due to the inroads made into its ranks by Dan Cupid and recruits for the different branches of the Women's Armed Services. In the meantime the instruments have remained unused and the general welfare officer came along with the idea of the boys' band. A great deal of credit is also due to the older members of the former band who have volunteered to do all they can to instruct the young musicians. At the present time no definite appointment of a leader for the band has been made but since there are several men in the town with the necessary qualifications it should not be difficult to have some one take complete charge so that when the instruments arrive citizens will have the pleasure of a weekly band concert in the public garden. Giving the young lads a certain amount of responsibility in affairs of this kind is bound to increase their respect for authority and thus help in a great measure to curb any tendency toward juvenile delinquency. -S
