Expect Dates On Market Here Soon

OTTAWA, Nov. 6 (CP)—In a few months Canadians will be enjoying some of the first fruits of victory-dates.

When war started Allied shipments of other dried fruits for the wartime information board said that with the opening of the Mediterranean shipping routes dates from Iraq will reach Canadian tables this winter.

Canada has been allocated 4,000 tons of dates, but they are not expected to arrive before Christmas.
