HANDS UP

Shot by Fellow-Student at Essex School—Would Not Box

Once more, the danger of young people being in possession of firearms has been demonstrated. The practice nearly ended in the death of Manuel Coello, a Spanish student at Forest House School, Woodford, when Frederick Sauri, sixteen, a Mexican, also a student at the school, was charged with attempted murder.

The inspector added that Sauri also told him that he purchased the revolver for \$5 about three months previously, and the revolver in question—an automatic one—with three live cartridges in it, was handed to him by one of the masters at the school.

In opening the case, Mr. Baines (prosecuting) said the scholars in the school were mostly foreigners, who resided there. Coello and Sauri went out for a walk, and Sauri alleged that Coello had played some tricks on him, and he would "have it back on him in some way."

Coello, a youth of sixteen, said when they got back to the school they went into Sauri's room and put on boxing gloves. Sauri wanted him to box, but he would not, and took off the gloves. Sauri then said, "I'm going to shoot you," and picked up a pistol, which was loaded, and "took aim."

German Battleships and Cruisers are to be Equipped

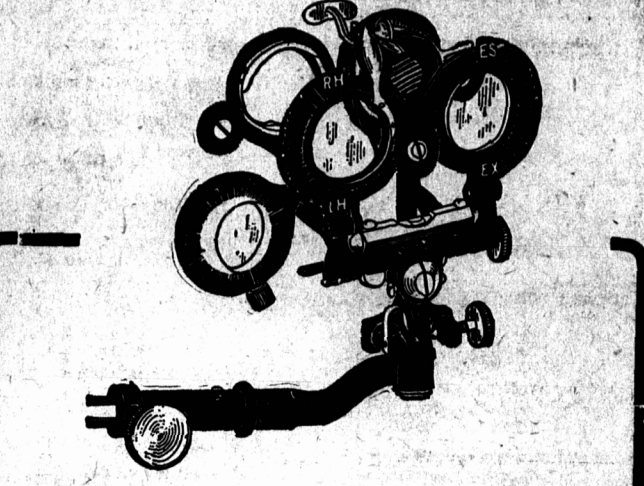
