PROGRESS AND ADVANCEMENT.

It is pleasing to note the indications on every hand that the City of Charlottetown, the Town of Summerside and the Province generally are waking up to new life and activity and moving forward with creditable strides.

Summerside, too is waking up, as becomes the Emporium of the West and is getting busy with water works sewerage and other noteworthy improvements while manfully restoring the desolation caused by the recent disastrous fire, and is also taking new interest in the tourist travel and all that makes for progress and advancement.

There is also a growing confidence that the transportation difficulties and winter grievances must and will be removed, and that when it is accomplished by means of the Tunnel, our fair Province will make progress by leaps and bounds.

Conflicts between the House of Lords and the House of Commons have been frequent in past years and the war is not over. The Liberal Premier is about to introduce a resolution, which will no doubt pass the Commons.

This seems a reasonable proposition. If adopted it would not prevent the Lords from altering or rejecting any measure first passed by the Commons.

The House of Lords has been of great service, as has our own Senate at times, in checking hasty legislation.

The present trouble arises over the rejection by the Lords of the Government Education Bill. This is a matter in regard to which the will of the people was clearly expressed at the general election and in regard to which the will of the people must and will in the end prevail.

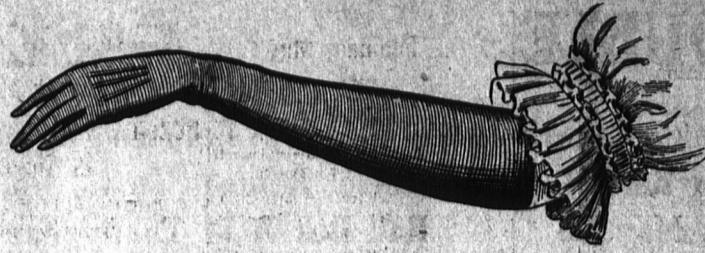
Beyond question Premier McBride is regarded on the Pacific coast as having done good service for his Province and having gained considerable prestige for himself by his recent mission to London.
