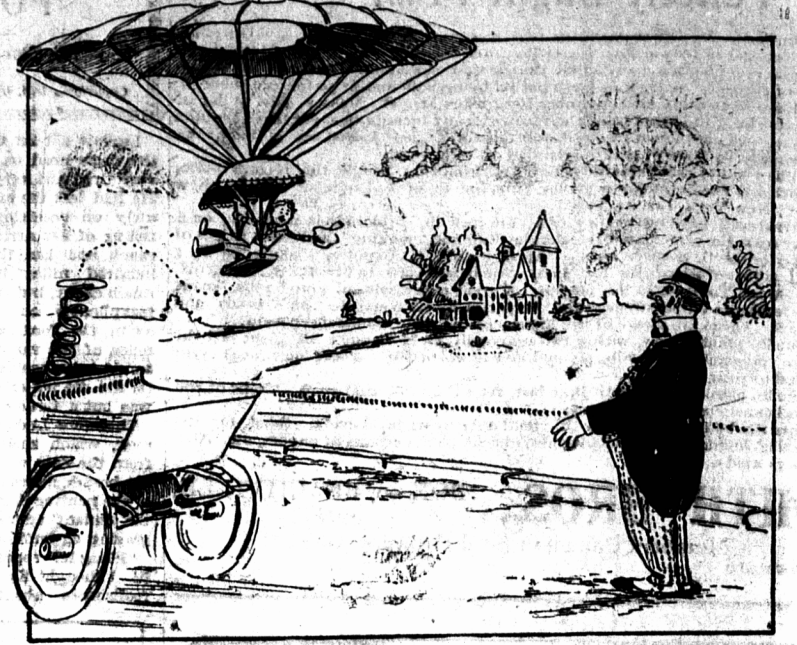
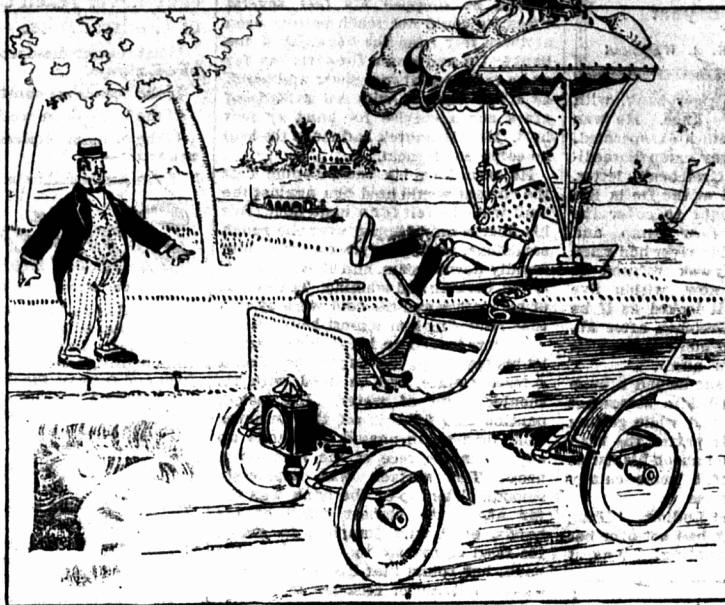
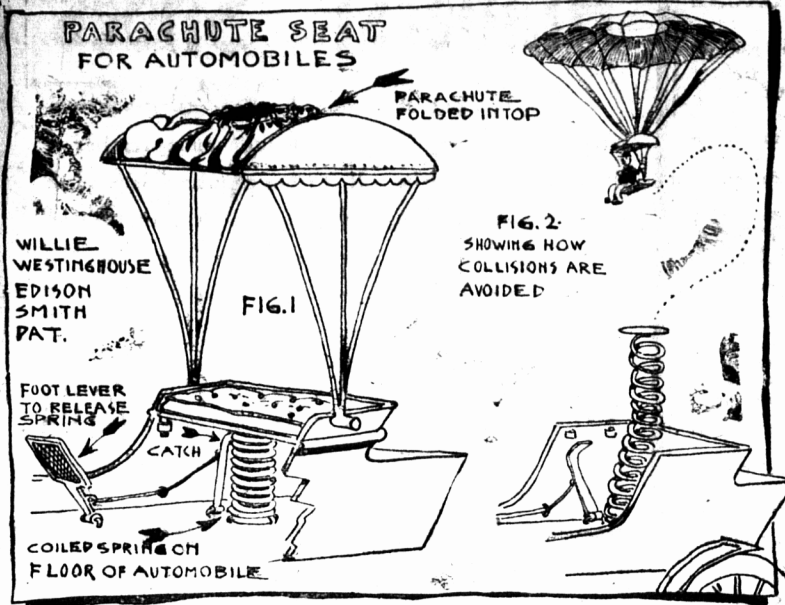


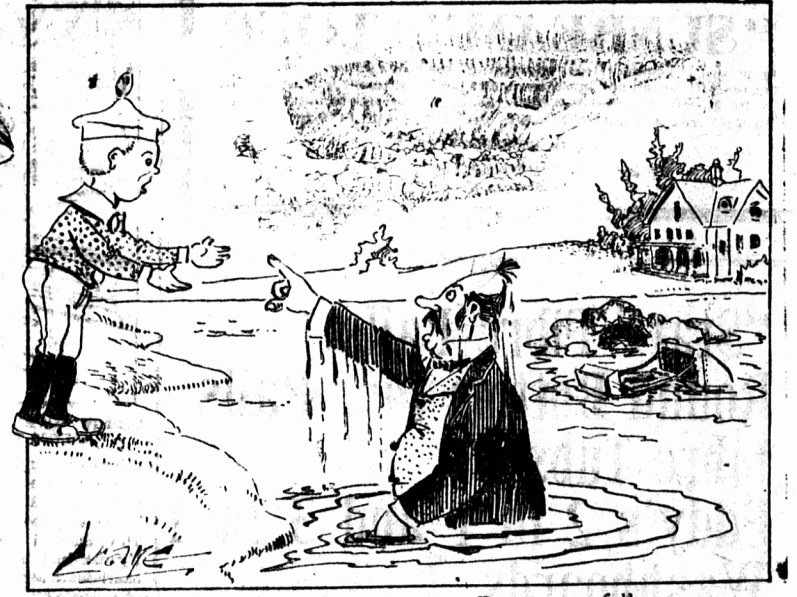
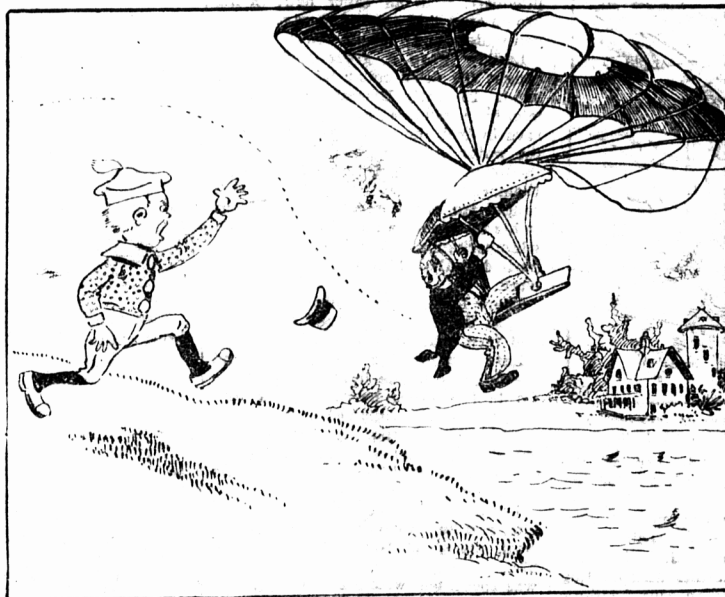
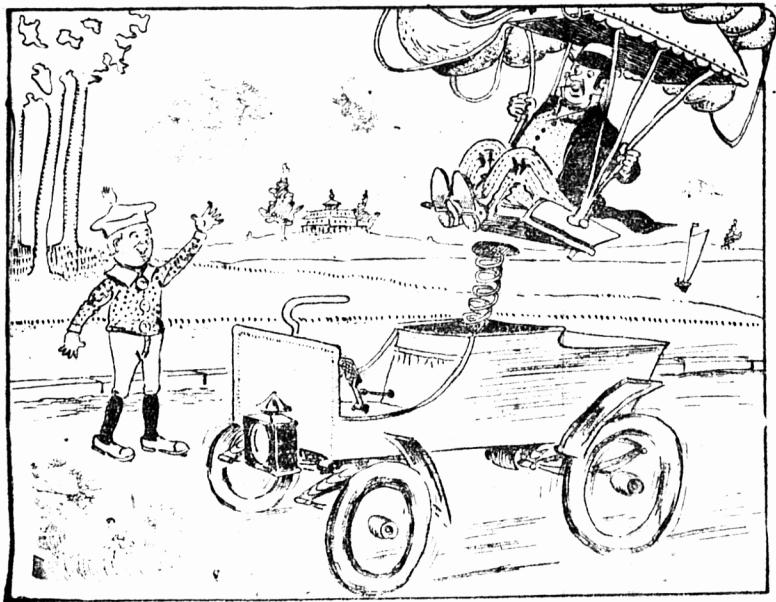
WILLIE'S SAFETY PARACHUTE WAS A SUCCESS—BUT THE WIND SHIFTED

And the parachute landed me gently on an adjoining lawn.

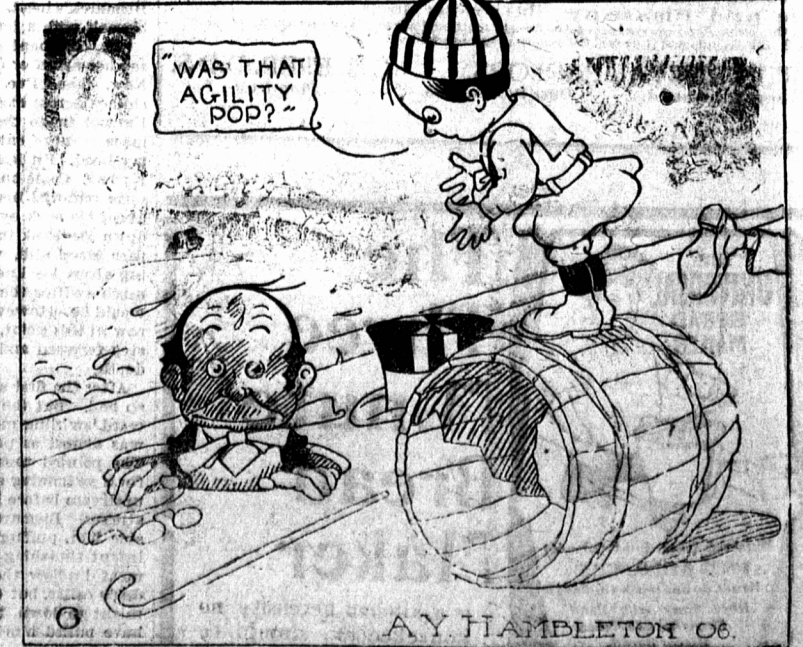
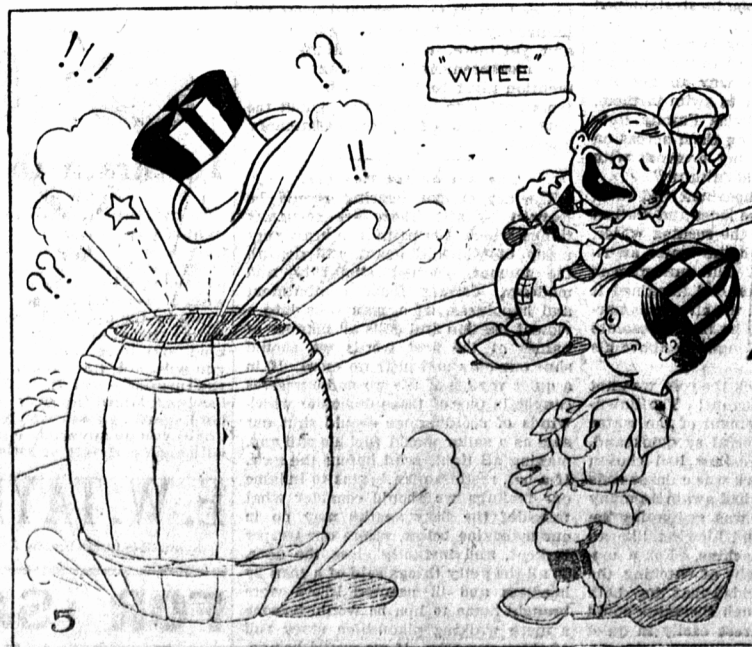


Then Papa tried it, but the wind had shifted—
