FOR THE MAGDALENS.—The C. G. S. Stanley will complete loading at Picou for the Magdalen Islands noon today and will call at Souris to take on cargo. The steamers Scotsburn and Guide are also loading cargo for the Magdalen.

MOTORED TO CITY —Messrs H. R. Profit and P. J. Rogerson, Victoria, and G. W. Profit, Kensington, motored in from Victoria Friday morning and returned in the evening. They report the roads in remarkably good condition, notwithstanding the recent frosts followed by so much wet weather.

NEW STEAMER.—The latest addition to the Canadian Government Merchant Marine fleet, the Canadian Trapper, launched a few days ago at New Glasgow, N. S., is now at Picou. She is commanded by Capt Gregor Fraser who formerly commanded the Canadian Miner.

NEW ISLAND VESSEL.—The Sydney Record says: The 190 ton stern schooner Anna McDonald has completed loading a cargo of coal at New Campbellton for Trinidad and is now about ready to sail. The vessel will spend the winter in the Gulf of Mexico-West India trade. She is a new craft and a fast sailer. Capt. McDonald, who has had her in commission for four weeks only, has now his fifth cargo on board. She has brought two cargoes of produce from Cardigan, P. E. I. and has taken two cargoes back. The Trinidad cargo makes her fifth.

THE MILD WEATHER.—The mild weather of the present month is quite a contrast to last year and is perhaps a greater boon than the public realize, particularly when the high price of coal is taken into the reckoning. The highest temperature yesterday was 34 degrees and the lowest 31 degrees. Friday a year ago the official mercury reading was 11 degrees below zero. The cold snap last year started on December 16 with 5 below; on the 17th and 18th it was 11 below and on the 19th 7 below. Navigation closed on the 17th and horses were crossing the Hillsborough River on the 18th.

NEW AND UP-TO-DATE SCHOOL.—Messrs A. and W. McAulay, Contractors, this city, have about finished their contract of building a new school house at Mount Mellick. The new school is a frame building 22 x 34 feet with porch attached, and besides the school room has two cloakrooms. The interior is handsomely finished in Douglas fir and has hardwood floors. It is made after the style of the modern country schools in Western Canada and is undoubtedly by the most up-to-date rural school in the province. The rate-payers are certainly to be congratulated upon their enterprise.
