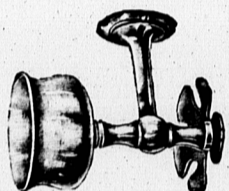
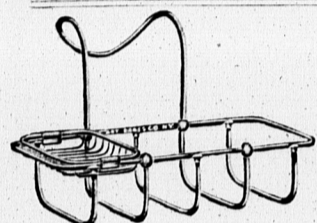

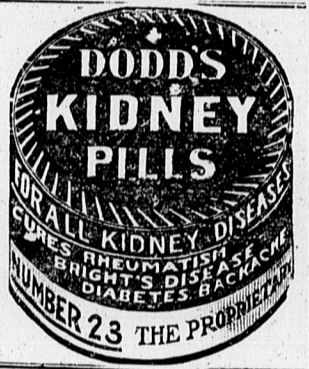

OTTAWA, Jan 6.—Something of a sensation was sprung in municipal circles to-day by the issuance of a writ against Dr. S. N. NEW ATTRACTIONS AT THE EDEN MUSEE

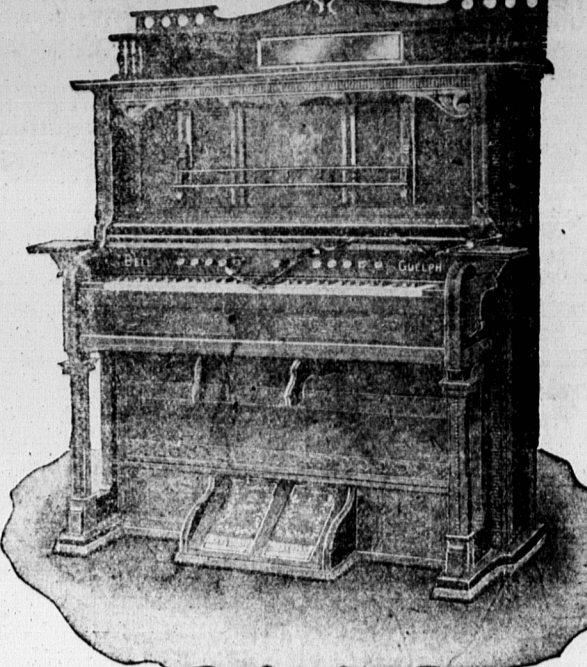
In New York City Is Very Great for the Holiday Season.

The holiday attractions at the Eden Musee of New York City, have been usually interesting and of a refined character. Most of these attractions will remain for several weeks. In addition a number of special features are to be added which will make the Musee unusually attractive. A number of new groups and figures have been placed on exhibition, including Mayor Gaynor and Peary of the North Pole. In the Winter Garden a bewildering combination of mysticism, magic and mystery will be given by the nephew of the great Herrmann and Prof Struck Company. In appearance young Herrmann closely resembles his uncle and his skill in magic is equally marvellous. Prof Struck will present his wonderful magical problems and illusions which apparently cannot be solved. A wonderful tableau entitled "The Children's Christmas Dream" will be given on the cinematograph. Many new moving pictures have been secured illustrating Christmas scenes and winter scenes in different countries. Other pictures show amusing scenes, sports and historical events. Moving pictures will be shown hourly afternoon and evening with a change of subjects at each exhibition. Professor Kapusky and his new orchestra will render choice selections at the afternoon and evening concerts.

SUMMERSIDE HAS AN UP-TO-DATE RINK

The opening of the new skating rink in Summerside has been an event of much interest to the citizens of that town and the new building is being made the subject of many commendatory remarks from all sides. Choosing a central location in the residential portion of the town, the Summerside Rink and Athletic Company Ltd, have erected a splendid building which, to suit the different purposes designed for it, fills the bill to a nicety. The rink is 181 feet long and 70 feet wide, and with side promenades eight feet wide and end promenades ten feet in width ample accommodation for spectators and skaters is afforded. The building is splendidly lighted at night by eight Tungsten Diffusers of about 700 candle power each and the many windows on all sides of the building make it a well lighted rink by day as well as by night. The dressing rooms are large and commodious and comfortably fitted up for the use of the patrons. Separate rooms are provided for hockey teams. The band stand is on the side of the new building and extends from its elevated position over the ice. The managers this year have engaged Prof Whitney's band and a standard of excellence in the selection of skating music most adaptable to the purpose will be set and maintained in this and all seasons to come. An exceptionally good point in the new rink is that the height of the lowest roof beams from the ice level is 29 feet, making the building specially adaptable for hockey. It is not the intention of the owners to allow the big building to remain idle in the summer months. Its floor space makes it an ideal place for a political meeting or any large public gathering. Exhibitions, shows or athletic sports could be held within its walls. Summerside is certainly to be congratulated on the possession of this up-to-date and modern skating rink and the promoters deserve every encouragement for their enterprise.
