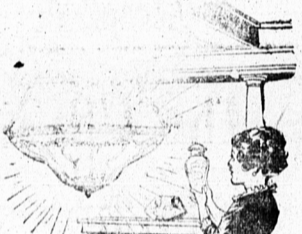

CARE OF CONTROL DEVICES

The Better They Are Maintained, The Better A Car Can Be Handled.

This is a plea for the proper lubrication and adjustment of these extremely important but unobtrusive parts, which are so commonly, almost utterly neglected, until they give definite trouble. WEALTHY LAUNDRESS

BOSTON, Mass., December 18.—Savings bank books covering deposits of \$32,000 were found today in the room of Miss Catherine Keefe, a laundress, who died recently. The amount represented the saving of a lifetime. She lived in the Field's Corner section, and her neighbors, in humble circumstances, never suspected that she was possessed of wealth. She was taken suddenly ill while at the wash-tub in the home of an employer and died there. A sister, Mrs. Mary Henry, of Westboro, who had not seen her in thirty-five years, was the only relative at the funeral.

MANY MILLS TO SHUT DOWN SOON

BOSTON, Dec. 18.—The Amoskeag Manufacturing Company of this city announces that on Wednesday night its eighteen cotton mills in Manchester, N. H., will be shut down until January 3 and that when they are reopened they will be operated three days a week under a wage reduction of 22 1/2 per cent, which will affect 17,000 operatives. The Stark mills of Manchester will run three days a week, at a reduced wage schedule similar to that of the Stark corporation have been adopted in other New Hampshire mills. The Singer Sewing Machine Company's plant, employing several thousand hands, has closed for two weeks and will cut wages from five to ten per cent. Notices of a 22 1/2 per cent. reduction have already been posted in the New England Cotton Mills, employing 150,000 operatives.

Maritime Hockey League Formed

Seven Teams Unite for Winter Sport At Meeting Held in Amherst.

AMHERST, T. S., Dec. 17.—With representatives present from Halifax, Moncton, New Glasgow, Sussex, Sackville, Charlottetown and Amherst, what will be known as the Maritime Independent Amateur Hockey League was organized here yesterday afternoon and last evening, with teams entered from Amherst, Halifax, Moncton and New Glasgow.

Sackville and Sussex withdrew from the organization on account of its independent character, and Charlottetown refused to enter owing to the long jumps between places which would be beyond their financial means to carry out. The league will be conducted on an amateur basis, but not according to the amateur definition as laid down by the C. A. A. E., the almost unanimous opinion of the delegates present being that this definition was impossible to live up to, and in reality nothing more than a farce. The Halifax club entering the league was the Imperoyal Club, one of the largest amateur athletic associations in the maritime provinces.
