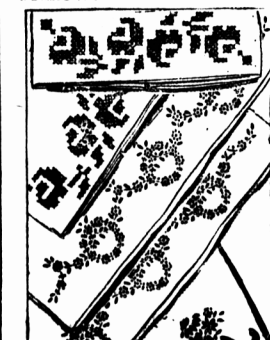

SPONGE RAISIN STRIPS
