WINDSOR, Ont., Oct. 31 (CP) — The Chrysler Corporation of Canada today announced that layoffs would start Monday. It is believed the first Canadian layoffs will be in Windsor, Ontario.

The company said in a statement that "as a result of lack of steel," layoffs will begin in its passenger car plant here Nov. 7.

Additional layoffs will begin about Friday, Nov. 11, the statement said, and "all passenger car production will be discontinued by Nov. 20, affecting a total of approximately 2,500 men."

Chrysler is one of Windsor's main industries and the second of three automobile manufacturing plants which are the life-blood of this city of 125,000.

The others — Ford Motor Company of Canada, Ltd. and General Motors of Canada Ltd.—say they have not yet laid off men because of the late start of the year.

schemes on a national basis, including a contributory old-age pension plan, would be within the field of federal jurisdiction.

At no time during constitutional debates in the Commons was the issue between Dominion and Provincial jurisdiction clearly defined.

Mr. St. Laurent said one point that on any controversy, the federal decision on interpreting the constitution would be left to the Supreme Court of Canada.

Shortly after the session, Premier Duplessis had indicated strong dissatisfaction with the government's action in going ahead with recent federal amendments instead of postponing them and discussing them at the conference.

The Government has indicated several times in recent weeks that it has no special legislation in mind which would depend on the conference reaching agreement on a procedure of constitutional amendment.

Federist Duplessis has not indicated definitely yet that he will attend the conference.

St. Dunstan's University Project Well Under Way

Work on the exterior of the combined chapel, convent and kitchen building under construction at St. Dunstan's University is practically completed, it was learned yesterday afternoon from Mr. Byron Crockett, supervisor of the construction job.

A central heating plant and laundry building is being erected a short distance north of the chapel building. The exterior of this building is expected to be finished in about three weeks.

Foundation forms have been laid and concrete is being poured for a new piggy. This is the first farm building to undergo construction since the destructive fire early this fall.

All that remains to be done to the exterior of the chapel building is to hang the roof and the installation of the windows. Work on the roof is expected to be completed in about three days.

The work that is now commencing on the interior of the building will be carried on all winter. Mr. Crockett stated that the building should be ready for use around June 1 next year.

The bricklayers are working on the walls of the central heating plant and laundry building and will probably be finished in another week. It was estimated that the roof would be laid in about two weeks. The boiler room will be 37x37 and the laundry 56x27 feet.

The new chapel building, almost a T-shaped structure, is situated east of the main building and northwest of Dalton Hall. The chapel wing is 110x46 feet and the convent is 140x43 feet.

It will contain dining hall on the ground floor running parallel with and below the chapel. At the top of the T and west of the dining hall are one large and two small bedrooms. The Sisters' dining room, kitchen storage and refrigeration rooms will be in this section. East of the kitchen will be the faculty dining room which will adjoin the main room.

The chapel will be on the first floor with side and end stairways leading from the dining hall and outside. There will be a small vestibule on the southwest corner of this floor. The top of the T will contain sick wards, general rooms, vestry and Sisters' chapel. The Sisters' sleeping quarters will be on the second floor. Above the chapel at the west end will be a balcony.
