MORNING MARKET LETTER

NEW YORK, May 14—As a result of the sharp drop in the market yesterday, the Dow Jones industrial average penetrated the April 28 closing low of 170.13 to close at 167.46 but the rail average closing at 57.27 still was holding above the April 28 resistance level of 56.61, therefore, while the increase in volume on the downside yesterday contributed to indications that the market may go lower, the down trend still is lacking in a Dow theory confirmation.

favourable factor tends to become any reasoning of an encouraging nature and operates to restrict prospective buyers for the longer pull. When the situation brightens, however, the supply of stocks may prove limited and a sharp technical rebound occur.

NOON COMMENT

The market has maintained a fairly good general level of prices this morning but on the other hand has not been called upon to resist any substantial amount of selling.
