#### AGAINST INTERVENTION IN MEXICO.

WASHINGTON, June 5.—Calling it a "Prussian proposition," Samuel Gompers, president of the A. F. of L., declared last night that war between the United States and Mexico would result from the carrying out of recommendations made by the senate committee which investigated Mexican affairs.

The report, he said, amounted to a declaration that unless the government of Mexico re-writes its constitution in accordance with the ideas of American oil and mining interests the government of the United States will "intervene" in Mexico.

"Those who know Mexico and the Mexicans," said Mr. Gompers, "understand fully that the sending of the suggested 'police force' into that country would mean war. This has long been desired by American interests engaged in the exploitation of the natural wealth of Mexico. Such a course as recommended must be opposed by every justice and freedom loving American."
