THE LEGISLATURE AND AUTOMOBILES.

The provincial Legislature by practically unanimous resolution has decided that motor cars shall hereafter be prohibited from running on the streets and highways of Prince Edward Island. And this resolution doubtless expresses the views and wishes of a very large majority of the people of the Province.

A good deal of disturbance, fear, inconvenience, some loss of property and what is worse, the permanent disabling of several persons has resulted from the introduction of the few autos that have been in use so far in this Island.

Here the feeling of hostility is confined to no one class, high or low. It is strongest, doubtless among the rural population, but many citizens, including leading merchants and even the judges of the land have joined in the general denunciation.

So far the House has only expressed its opinion by resolution. That in no way affects the status of the automobile before the law. But we are left to assume that the unanimous resolution of the House will be crystallized into law, and that the law will be prohibitory rather than regulative or restrictive.

Our small community cannot always stand out against the customs of the great world. We may lead, or move in the van of progress in the direction in which the world is moving, as we have done in prohibiting the liquor traffic.

THE CASE FOR THE TUNNEL.

It was in 1891 that Sir Wilfrid Laurier wrote the editor of The Guardian that "Every man who has given any attention to the condition of things and the necessities involved by the entering of the Island into Confederation must admit that such a Tunnel must be constructed if the thing is reasonably practicable."

The demands of our transportation have doubled since then. The worst interruptions of our winter communications have since occurred. The ability of the Dominion to build great public works has much increased. At that date the annual expenditure of Canada was a modest thirty-six millions. It has now reached one hundred millions.

Sir Wilfrid's letter blazes upon the public record, an unfulfilled pledge. If he does not speedily take action to make good his words how can he appeal with any confidence to the people of Prince Edward Island for support?

DR. THOMPSON'S CONVERSION.

THE HUNGRY SWARM.

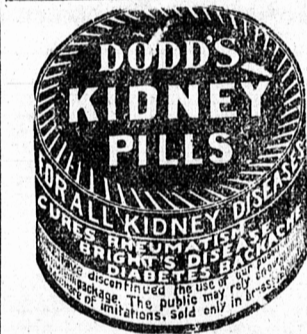

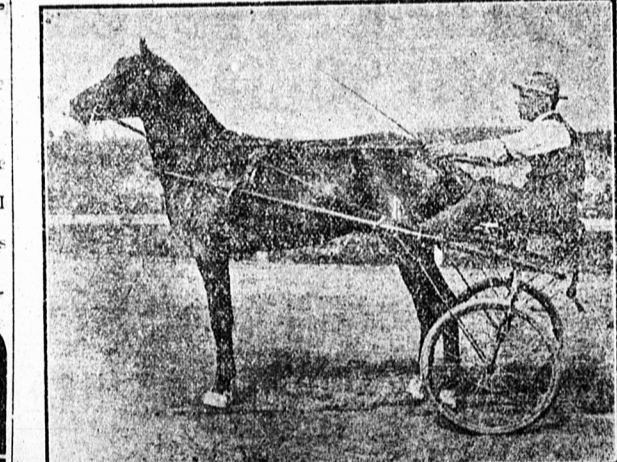
