WINNIPEG, Jan. 10 - (CP) - Prices rallied briskly to gain ground on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today, after starting weakly and posting initial declines. Commercial demand supplanted selling in oats and barley during a moderately active late session, while rye came in for good buying from American interests. Flax was quiet throughout the session. In export business, approximately 1,600,000 bushels of Canadian wheat went to the United Kingdom under the long-term agreement. Prices of class two wheat moved up one cent to \$2.14.
