The cause of numerous diseases and disagreeable habits, heretofore ascribed to constitutional have been traced directly to the teeth. Hindering digestion, causing loss of flesh, weak eyes, driving on one side and irregular teeth. Rough edges and sharp corners of the teeth irritate the mouth, and at the same time cause general debility, nervous indigestion and general debility. Decayed teeth cause necrosis of the bone, abscesses, nasal discharges, etc. These abscesses should be removed. Decayed teeth should be removed by extracting or trepanning, sharp corners and rough edges should be smoothed down and elongated and uneven surfaces and irregularities should be smoothed down. The common flat, or file here will not suffice, but special instruments of the purpose are necessary.
