**Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Homestead Regulations.**

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 24, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, who has a permanent residence in the Dominion of Canada.

Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated.

Entries must be made personally at the local and office for the district in which the land is situated.

A homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the settlement as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.

(3) Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands, Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent.
