THE ALLEGED CABINET CRISIS IN ALBERTA.

A cabinet crisis in Alberta affords an illustration of the adage that it is the unexpected that happens. The Province is rich, its treasury full, population is flowing in, it has had excellent crops, and in its Legislature of 41 members Conservatives are about as scarce as hen's teeth.

Public men in Alberta have expensive ideas, as befits the dwellers on the boundless prairies. They think nothing of putting a million dollars or so into a Parliament building and pay their Premier \$6,000, and other ministers \$5,000 each besides a seasonal indemnity of \$1,000 which all members of the Legislature receive.

A LIBERAL OF THE OLD SCHOOL.

The death of John Charlton, who for almost a generation represented North Norfolk in the House of Commons, is announced. He had attained the good old age of 81 years. Mr. Charlton entered Parliament in 1872, was active in defeating the Macdonald Government in the following year, a staunch supporter of the Mackenzie Administration during its term of office and was one of the ablest advocates of the Liberal cause during the eighteen years of Conservative rule which followed.

of his party and an earnest advocate of measures for the moral welfare of the country down to 1904, when failing health compelled him to retire from public life. Mr. Charlton was a man of signal ability and high character who served his country faithfully and well. In business he was a successful lumber merchant. He was also a very prominent member of the Presbyterian Church.
