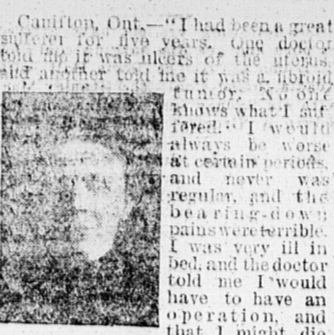

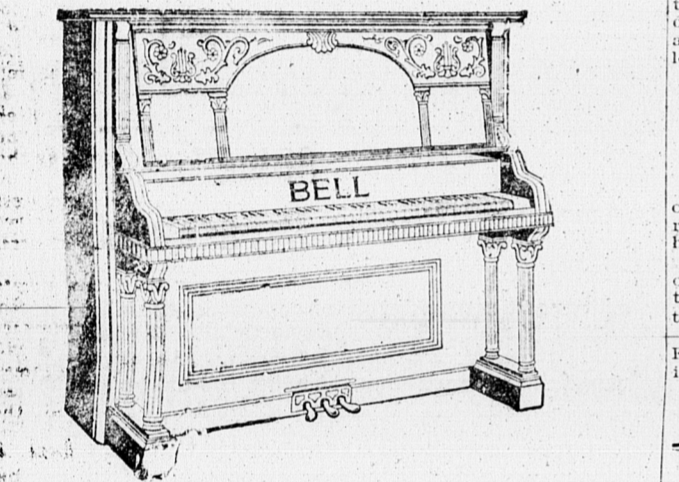

VICTORIA, Nov. 9.—Following the rising of the Skena River last Tuesday, in which a Supply Train of the Provincial Government was routed the party was attacked by Chief Maitland Douglas with 60 men, hastily enlisted in the Upper River district, who attacked the rebellious tribesmen at day-break yesterday, at Kisplox.
