Livestock

MONTREAL, Nov. 14—(CP)—All classes held steady on Montreal livestock markets today. Receipts: cattle 446; sheep and lambs 261; hogs 1,123; calves 441. The cattle offered were made up of mostly common to just plain quality cows. Common to medium heifers brought \$3.50 to \$5.50. Medium cows made \$4.25 to \$4.75 and common butchers from \$3.50 to \$4. Canners and cutters \$2.50 to \$3.25 and common bulls \$3.50 to \$4 with fleshy bulls around \$4.50.

Bacon hogs were \$9 fed and water-ly and \$9.25 off trucks. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were from \$8.25 to \$8.75. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$12 hot weight.
