


—There is little change in the Summerside produce market, oats and potatoes remain the same price as last quoted.

—Mrs. McCallum, wife of John McCallum, contractor, Bedeque, died last night after a protracted illness. Mrs. McCallum will be better known to many Guardian readers as Miss Bessie Binns, daughter of the late Charles Binns of Charlottetown. The funeral takes place tomorrow from her home in Bedeque.

—In the November number of the "Canada West," magazine appears the first installment of a very interesting story "The remittance man" by W. H. P. Jarvis, also an excellent photo of Mr. Jarvis. Mr. Jarvis or "Duffy" as he was known around Summerside and who is obtaining quite a name as a writer, is a son of the late Dr. Jarvis who formerly practised in Summerside.

—The steamer Campana Capt. Demers, left Summerside yesterday about six o'clock, p. m. for Montreal with a very large cargo as follows: 2560 bags potatoes, 300 barrels oysters, 325 cases canned goods, lobsters and chicken two tons dressed pork, nineteen tons beef, four horses and sundries. This was the last trip of the steamer to this port and many were present to bid the captain goodbye.

—In the November edition of the Maple Leaf published in Oakland, Calif., appears an excellent cut of the new barber shop of C. Lafferty, Summerside. —After a period of suspense, Mrs. F. D. Beer, of Summerside, has received a letter from her son, Captain Geo. S. Beer, of the O. R. C. Constabulary, stating that under the new government arrangements, he has been moved from Winberg to Jagersfontein. Winberg, his old station, is a quiet farming place while Jagersfontein is a very important diamond mining town. After long consideration of the government they dismissed all except four inspectors, and Captain Beer having the honor of being the senior of the remaining four, has been given a division 300 miles long, which involves much travelling and hard work.
