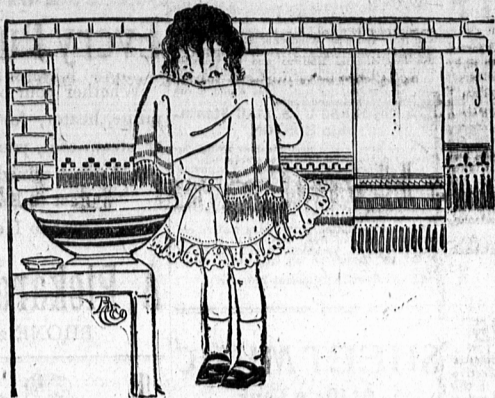

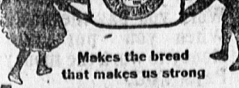

## 300,000 BARRELS OF N. S. APPLES EXPORTED

HALIFAX, Feb. 17.—Nova Scotia's apple shipments from Halifax to the old country markets amount so far this season to 3,000 barrels. There are 25,000 barrels yet to be shipped, which will make a total of 325,000 barrels, 10,000 less than last year.

Chief Fruit Inspector Vroom said the

falling off in the shipment is solely the result of crop shortage, as the demand across the water is just as good as last year, while the prices are fully one-third better. The varieties commanding the higher figures are the King, Golden Russets, Blenheim and Baldwin, the average net to the grower or shipper being \$2.50 per barrel.

## ROTSCHILD CO. ONLY SAILED FOR CANADA

MONTREAL, Feb. 17.—The 100 emigrants who were afforded a new start in life by the Rothschild emigration scheme, have bidden adieu to their old homes. There are no "wasters" in "unemployables." Every one has a situation and a home ready for him whenever he reaches the destination arranged for.

As far as possible only one family will be placed in a locality in Canada, and a small amount of money has been sent to whatever point the emigrant is going to.

To those who are going Rothschild has spoken cheering words. "It is through

men like you that Canada has become great," said he to the emigrants, who had a most enthusiastic send off. Thousands assembled in the neighborhood of St. John's hall at St. John's Hill.

The emigrants sailed on the Lake Champlain for St. John (N. B.)

The committee of the Queen's unemployed fund have granted the Salvation Army \$2,500 for emigration to Canada. A similar amount for similar purposes will be added by the Salvation Army. The fund thus created is to be administered by a committee, on which the queen's fund will be represented.

## DIAMOND ROBBERY IN VANCOUVER

VANCOUVER, B. C., Feb. 17.—A daring diamond robbery occurred here whereby A. F. McMillan, jeweler, is the loser to an extent of between \$15,000 and \$20,000. His store is located in the Jones block, at the corner of Hastings and Homer streets, next to the Homer bank, and is one of the most frequented spots. A heavy fog, however, enveloped the city early in the evening, and this aided the thief. About the time mentioned the people in the neighborhood were startled by a very heavy crash and the cries of

"Stop thief." It was soon ascertained that a daring robbery had occurred. The thief threw a brick through a plate glass window and snatched two trays of valuable diamonds and rushed off. He was seen by one or two pedestrians, but owing to the fog he was quickly lost to sight. They can only give a meagre description, and the police have made no arrests so far. McMillan is said to have come here from Winnipeg. He opened last November. He is now in the east.

## RUMORED ROW IN TURKEY

CONSTANTINOPLE, Feb. 17.—According to statements emanating from Turkish sources, Marshal Ahmed Fezi Pasha, commanding the Turkish troops in Yemen, has returned to Sanaa with at least 100 prisoners. He has announced the complete success of his expedition against the Yemen rebels. Nevertheless the operations against the important fortress at Shakara, which is occupied by rebels, have been abandoned, the besiegers leaving four guns behind owing to a lack of transport facilities.
