QUEBEC, Nov. 12 A flood of actions for damages is about to pour upon the Quebec Bridge Company, following Mr. Cooper's evidence relative to the Quebec bridge disaster. W. H. Davidson, K. C., attorney for the bridge workers, had taken eight actions within a week or two of the catastrophe. He has now in hand instructions to sue from the representatives of at least fifty victims of the disaster, including those upon which he has already acted.

The amounts claimed by the different plaintiffs will run from ten to twenty thousand dollars, according to the circumstances of the victims and of their representatives.



### Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 36, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section 40 acres, more or less.  
Applications for entry must be made person by the applicant as a Dominion Land Agent or Sub-agent for the district in which the land is situated. Entry by proxy may however be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homestead holder.  
The homesteader is required to perform the homestead duties under one of the following plans:  
(1) At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.  
(2) A homesteader may, if he so desire perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead, or upon a share in land will no meet this requirement.  
(3) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased of a homesteader, he may perform residence on farming land owned solely by him not less than eighty (80) acres in extent in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father or mother.  
The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as meaning not more than five miles in a direct line, exclusive of the width of road allowances crossed in the measurement.  
(4) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself must notify the agent for the district of such intention.  
Six months notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Lands at Ottawa, of intention to apply for a patent.
