TOMATOES WIN BATTLE WITH NORWEGIAN RATS

EDMONTON, Oct. 9 (CP)—Tooth to tooth street fighting scraps by North Edmonton tomcats backed by the artillery of sharpshooting rodents have succeeded in repelling an invasion of rats to the city of big, tough Norwegian rats.

Co-operating with the City Health Department, the cats which nightly prowled the North Edmonton dump, battled the fierce rodents, killing two of them.

The first encounter eliminated two-thirds of the disease-spreading rats, apparently brought here in a shipment of goods from Eastern Canada or the United States.

A short time later a North Edmonton citizen put up a rat trap to the third invader and added a note to his 22 rifle. After a search to uncover further intruders the health authorities expressed confidence that the threepart plague had been stopped and Edmonton was once again ratless.
