CARE OF THE OILING SYSTEM

INCREASING THE EFFICIENCY

An effective way to increase the efficiency of a high-speed engine is to bevel off the sharp edges of each piston ring on the face adjacent to the cylinder walls...

RADIATOR HOSE

The rubber hose at the top and the bottom of the radiator should be renewed at least once a year...

STUCK VALVES

There are times when one of the push rod valves sticks in its guide and causes the motor to misfire...

A SCREW HINT

When necessary to start a screw in such a position that it cannot be held with the fingers, take a piece of soft wire and give it a few turns around the screw...

GEAR RATIO

A method for determining the gear ratio of the differential gears is to count the teeth of each and divide the number of teeth of the smaller gear into the larger...

DON'T DO IT

If necessary to crank the motor by hand, don't press down on the starting crank. Pull on it only and avoid a broken wrist.
