NEW YORK, Dec. 27—Although aggressive traders made frequent efforts to force a downward movement in the stock market, the tone held firm during the afternoon with a recovering tendency noted wherever pressure from the professional sources had caused declines. Consolidated Gas continued to attract attention and after a sharp re-action resumed its upward movement, selling in the late trading at a new high range for the day. During the last half hour the market was raised again and prices closed generally about 1/2 to 1/4 per cent below the previous low level of the day. There is no conclusion to be gathered from such a highly professional affair as today's market has been except that the public are disinclined to do anything except to buy a few bonds for investments.
